

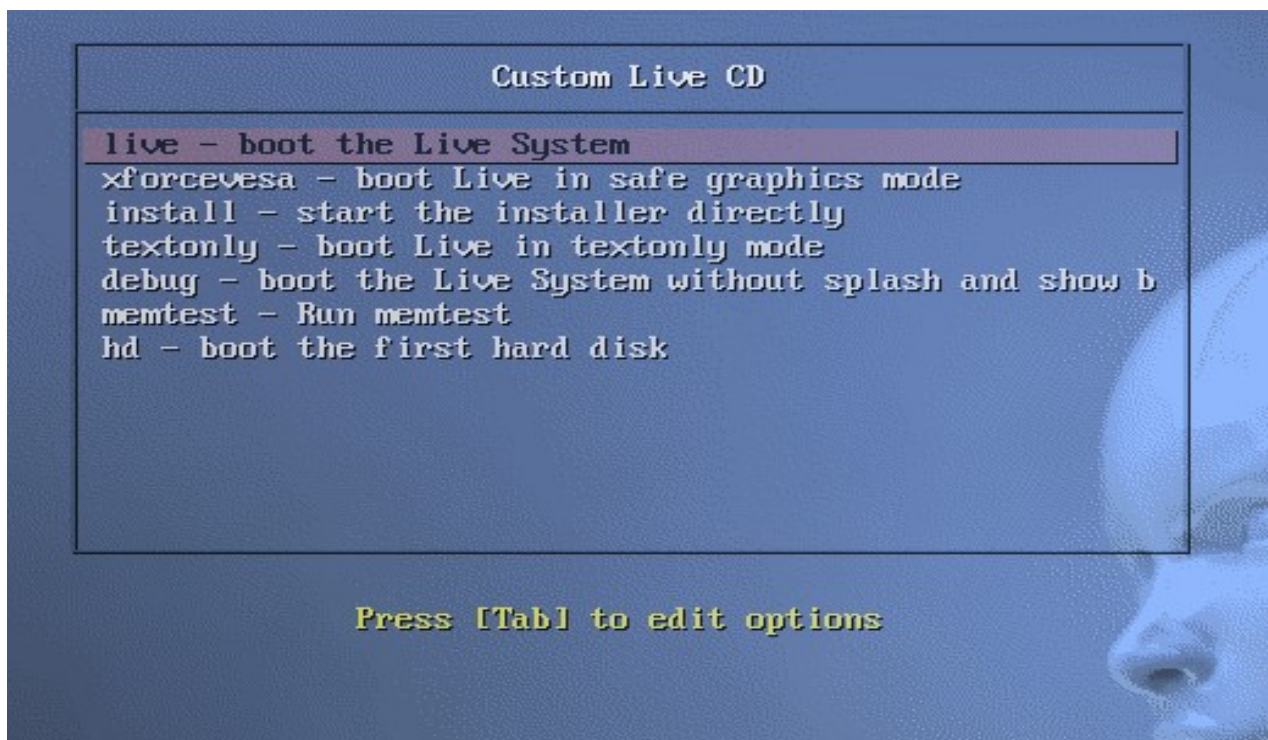
Ubuntu 14.04 Installation

Note: Before follow the below steps please take back up of your documents, Music, picture and all the files

It's easy to install Ubuntu 14.04 from a DVD . Here's what you need to do:

Put the Ubuntu DVD into the DVD-drive

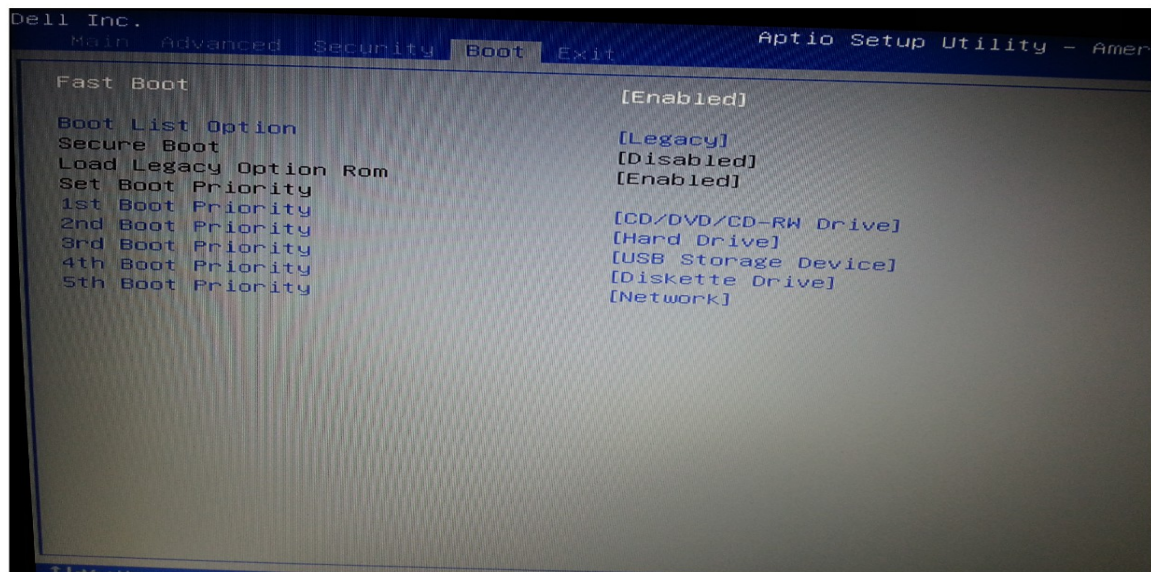
1. Restart your computer. You should see a welcome screen as shown in the below screen.



Note: Select Install-Start the installer directly. (In the above screen mouse will not work)

If you don't get this menu, you have to set up BIOS first boot device as DVD drive, for this please follow below steps

- Restart your computer, computers require you to hold down or press a key to entering a BIOS. The most common way to enter the BIOS is to press the DELETE key and in few models it will be either of (F2,F10,F8 or F12).

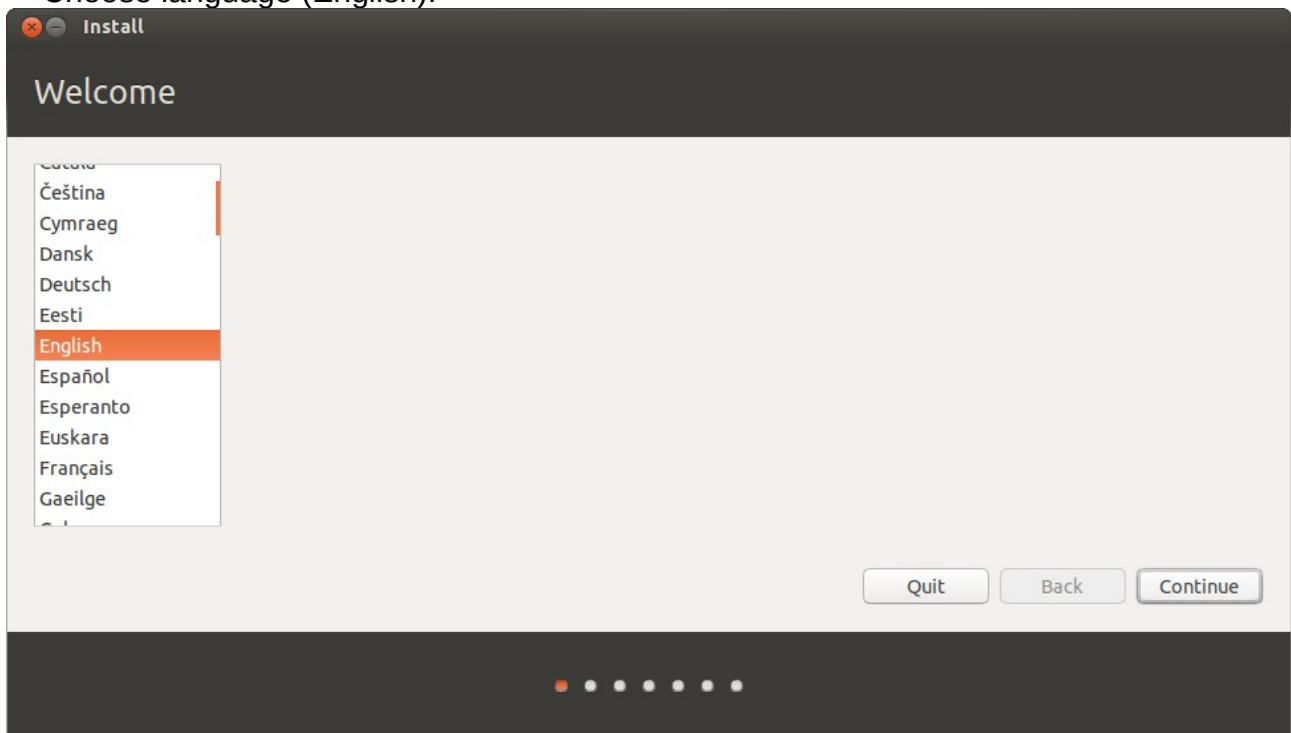


- In the above screen you have to select DVD drive as First boot devices then press F10 and save it.

Now you will see the 1st screen as explained in the first step.

2. Welcome screen :

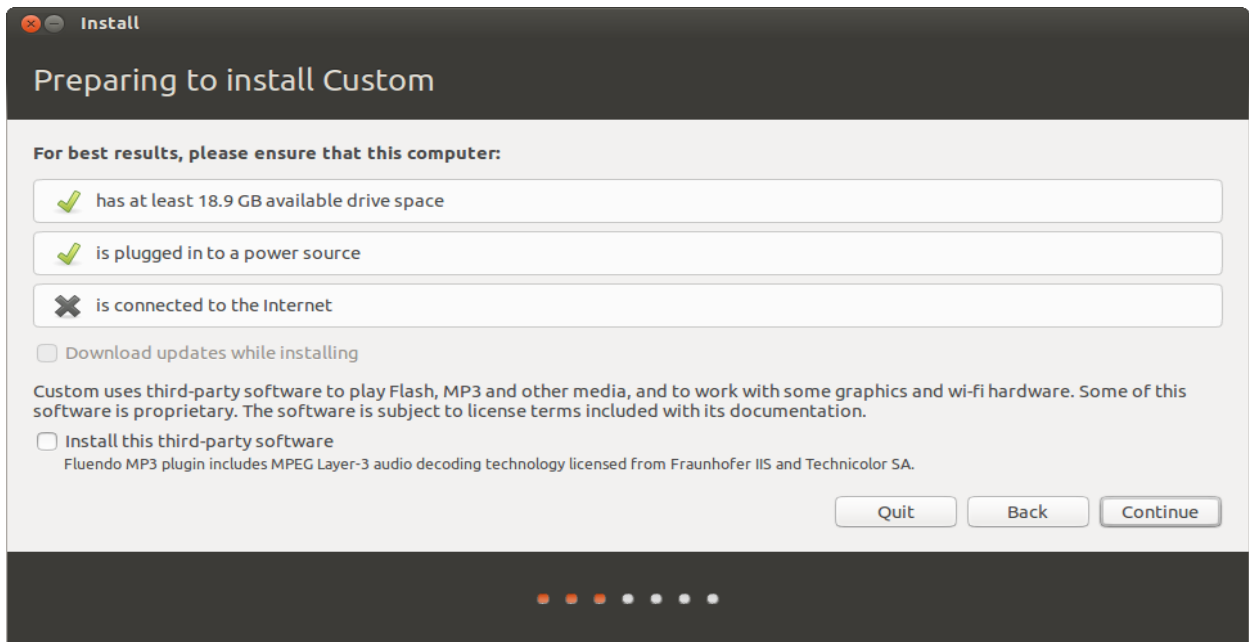
Choose language (English).



Click on Continue...

3. Prepare to install Ubuntu :

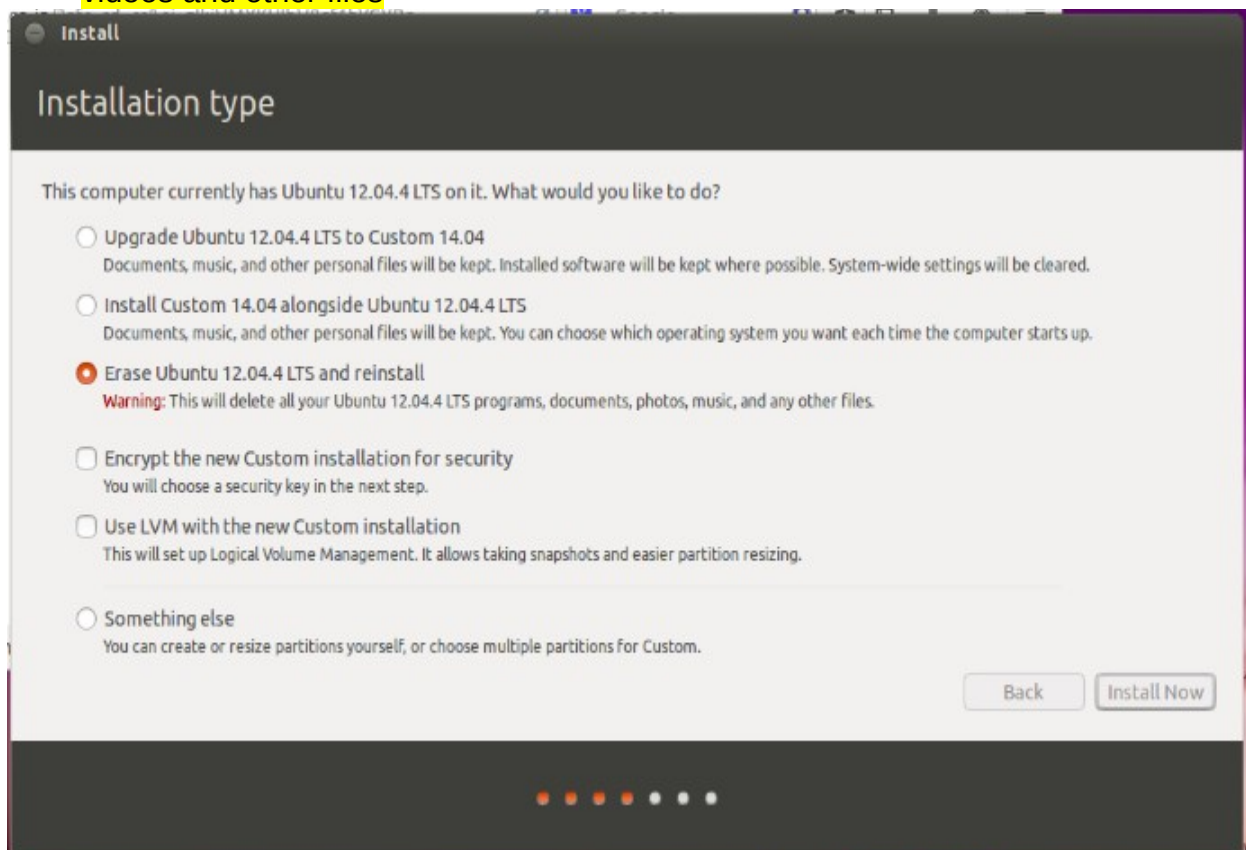
Make sure your system has enough free space (at least 18.9 GB) in installation directory , connected to Internet (optional) & power source.



Click on Continue...

4. In the next screen, you will be asked for the **installation options**. Select the **Erase Ubuntu 12.04 and install Ubuntu 14.04** radio button

Warning: This selection will delete all your ubuntu 12.04 files, documents photos, videos and other files



Click on Continue...

NOTE:

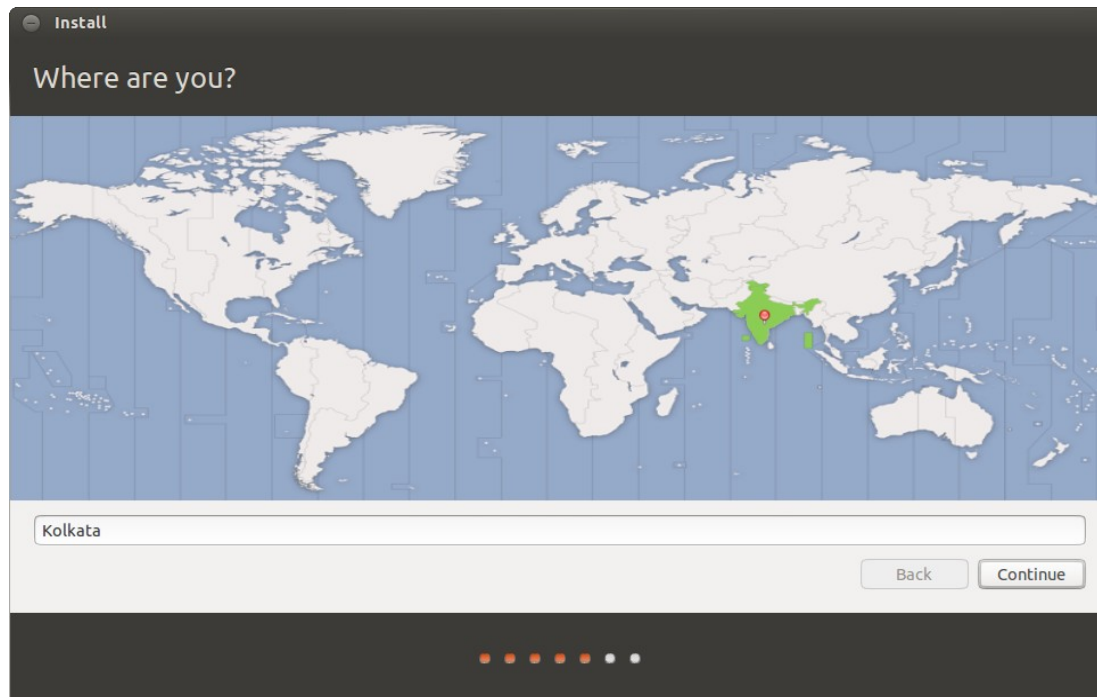
1. If you select Upgrade ubuntu 12.04 LTS to Custom 14.04 :-
 - For this computer should be connect to the internet

- It will upgrade from the ubuntu server.

2. Install custom 14.04 alongside Ubuntu 12.04 LTS :-

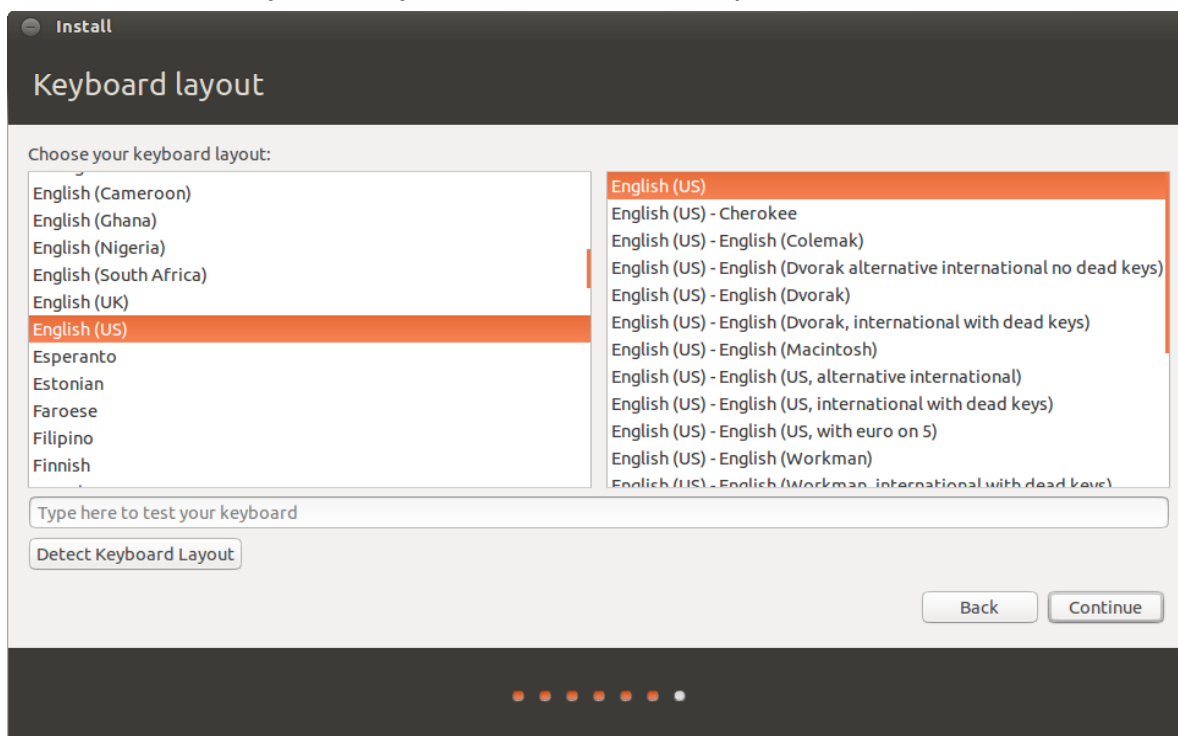
- It will keep both ubuntu 12.04 and 14.04 in the same computers.

5. Choose Time zone and press **Continue** (In the mean time setup will continue in the background, to set for Indian Standard Time click on India).



Click on Continue...

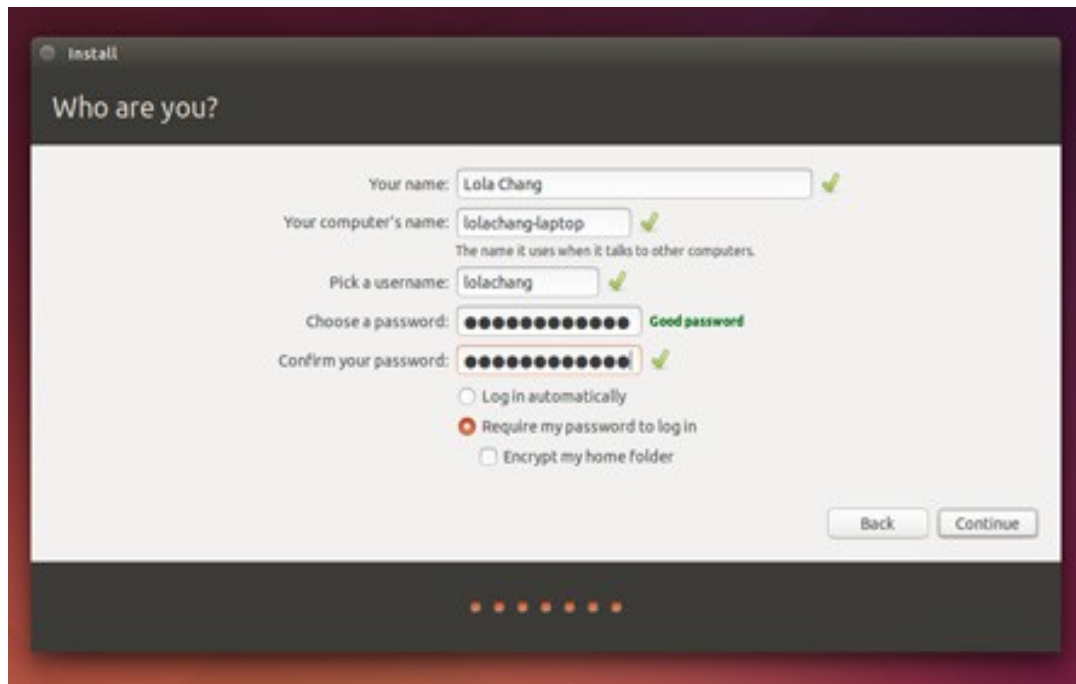
6. Now choose keyboard layout , leave as it is and press **Continue**.



Click on Continue...

7. Type name , computer name , username (for login) and password . By default it will

take “Ubuntu” as username and “Ubuntu” as password.



Click on Continue...

8. It will proceed with the rest of the installation.
9. Press **Restart now** and remove installation media(CD/DVD/USB) while rebooting.
